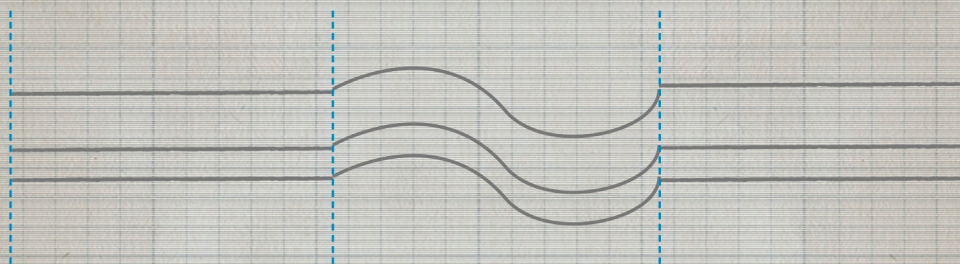
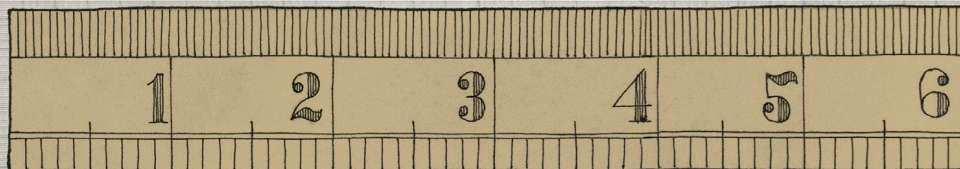
Architects use lines, color, space, texture, form, shape, and value to create their designs.
